DOWN ON THE FARM

Salt & Pepper sets about the farm family and farming are old and new. Here is a variety of shakers sets about life down on the farm.....



Many farms had a Silo or two by the barn to store grain. The HARVESTORE company gave the Farmer a set of shakers when he bought one of their Silo's. This set is 4 3/4" high with 3&3 holes and red plastic stoppers, made in the USA in the 1960s.







A Farmer on a stool milking his Cow. The cow doesn't like being milked and kicked over the pail and spilled the milk! This set is 2" high with 1&2 holes and was made to have scotch tape over the fill holes instead of having stoppers. When you see that you know it is an old set from the 1930s or 40s and was probably made in the USA.





The Farmers and his Wife. This set is 4" high with an 'OMC Japan' sticker and rubber stoppers. Rubber stoppers started in the late 1950s so this set is probably from the 1960s.





A fine Barn and Hay Wagon only 1 1/4" high with 1&1 holes. The miniature size, the gold detail and the holes tell you this set was made by Arcadia Ceramics in California in the 1950's. They also had flat bottoms for scotch tape to cover the fill holes. They originally gave glued to a paper base with a plastic bubble over it and these still have paper stuck over the holes on the base.



A Farmer on his Tractor by his Barn. That Barn is way too small isn't it?! The set is only 2 1/4" high with 2&3 holes and was also made to have scotch tape over the fill holes instead of stoppers - just like the farmer milking his cow!







In 1998 the Heartland Chapter had New Rose Ceramics make this John Deere Combine condiment set. The front roller is the 1-piece shaker, the spoon is the long chute along the top and the mustard lid is the very top cover. Overall it has 4 pieces and is 3 1/2" high with 8&8 holes.






















In 1998 ENESCO came out with an 'AMERICAN FAVORITES' series which included this John Deere Tractor pulling a Corn Wagon. The set is 2 1/2" high with 1&3 holes, made in China. The wagon hooks onto the tractor just like old metal toys do.





The John Deere Company had this **Farmer** sitting on Tractor by his barn made in China in 2000. The set is 3" high with 1&2 holes.
